But these facilities come at a cost, both in financial terms and in the time and effort needed to run and maintain them. Our annual costs for Gas and Electric, rent rates and insurance, cleaning and refuse disposal, together are more than £10,000.

Most of this cost is covered by the money we earn from hiring out the room. Thanks to Jo Osborn this year we have achieved a record level of bookings. The balance has to be made up from sponsorship, social events and your individual subscriptions.

Sponsorship has been very important in recent years, as often mentioned in the Newsletter. Thanks to Bommer and his many supporters we have improved the Dressing Rooms, created the Cresta Lounge, brightened up the ladies toilets, renewed the bar cellar, offered smart club shirts and provided excellent playing equipment.

A Message from Afghanistan

Sorry not sent one of these sooner but internet access hasn't been easy.

Been deployed forward into the Nad Ali region for the first 4 months of the tour with M Coy 42 Commando Royal Marines. Working in small CPs (checkpoints) as a single medic within a multiple of 14-16 blokes.

Being the only medic means I'm in demand and normally complete 2 patrols a day and sometimes one of a night too. Luckily apart from the all the patrolling I've not had a lot to do and haven't had to put any emergency medic skills into practice. Nothing wrong with having a bored medic! Though a lot of that is down to fact that that "the ban" as we call the Taliban can't shoot and rely on spray and pray tactics.

Had enough of the heat out here its low 40's on a cool day. I'll never moan about standing on the Essington pitches in shorts in horizontal rain freezing my bits off again. Will try and send a few more messages before the end of my tour in October now I can get on the internet more.

Good luck against the Crabs from RAF Costford. Wish I could join you for a crack at the Air Force as they bugged up the flights I was suppose to be on and lost 3 days of my RNR.
